



If you have any questions about your medicine, there is no one better to ask than a medicine expert—your pharmacist!

Below are some examples of questions that your pharmacist can answer. Feel free to add your own!

- Should I take it in the morning/at night?
- Can I drive while taking this medicine?
- Should I take this medicine with food to avoid an upset stomach?
- If I do get an upset stomach when taking this medicine, is there anything I can do to help?
- Are there any foods I should avoid eating while taking this medicine?
- Are there other formula options (chewable, dissolvable, liquid, patch form, etc.)?
- Does it come in any flavor options?
- What can I do if I can't swallow pills?
- Do I have to take it with water? How much water should I take with it?
- Can I split my pills in half if the medicine is too large?
- Is this medicine addictive?
- If I become tolerant (needing more of the medicine to get the same effect) to this drug will the dosage be increased?
- Is there another option with less possible side effects?
- Is there a way I can save money on this prescription?
